
President's Message

Executive Committee Meeting in Adelaide Reports

22 and 23 February 2006

Next World Congress in Hungary

- I It was decided that early and later registration of the ISDE members would be €500 and €550, for nonmembers it would be €600 and €650, for trainees €160 and €200, and for accompanying persons it would be €80 regardless of the time of registration.
- 2 Hungarian organizers agreed that an independent and separated website would be very useful, and that this would be linked to the original website at www.isde.net
- 3 It was also decided that the formal structure of the Montreal congress would be followed.
- 4 The organizing scientific committee would be constructed by Kahrilas, in combination with Tullassay and Ferguson.

Blackwell Publishing Report

There was a report that the number of manuscripts to the Journal has doubled in 2005. In 2006 and 2007, 6 issues will be published. As for 2008, it may be raised to 8 issues and perhaps 10 issues in 2010. The contract between ISDE and Blackwell Publishing will end in 2006. Both sides wish to continue.
