

2019 Best Junior Faculty/Trainee Manuscript Award

Deadline Extension

In view of the impact of Co-Vid-19 pandemic on academic work, we are extending the deadline for the application to May 15, 2020

Diseases of the Esophagus will be giving an award to the top original research manuscript by a junior faculty or trainee author accepted for publication in the journal.

Award

- The winner of the award will receive waived congress registration fee, 2 nights accommodation at the congress hotel, and a travel grant of \$750 USD to attend the 2020 ISDE world congress in Toronto, Canada. The travel grant will provide reimbursement for travel expenses for the award winner and will be processed after the congress.
- The winner of the award will be recognized in the September 2020 issue of *Diseases of the Esophagus* and will be recognized in person at the 2020 ISDE world congress in Toronto, Canada.

Judging Criteria

The winner of the award will be determined by the co-Editors in Chief of *Diseases of the Esophagus*. Criteria that will be considered will include

- Contribution of the junior faculty or trainee author
- Scientific methodology of the manuscript
- Clinical impact of the manuscript
- Citations accumulated within the first 6 months of publication
- Media impact within the first 6 months of publication

Qualifications

- The first author of the manuscript must be a trainee physician or a junior faculty physician with less than 5 years from completion of training at the time of submission for publication.
- The manuscript must have been accepted for publication in *Diseases of the Esophagus* between January 1, 2019 and December 31, 2019.

- Cover letter by applicant outlining their personal contribution to the published manuscript
- Letter from mentor / senior author stating the level of training or date of completion of training for the applicant at the time of manuscript submission
- Published manuscript
